I said "Oh it would take me a year and a day to walk over there." This same man said "Oh that's no problem. I'll come over with a wheel chair and get you." I haven't gone over yet, but intend to soon. They open doors for me. The women as well as the men are very friendly. I think there are about 100 apts in here.

I just got a permanent, I told my grandchildren "I'm going to get my teeth fixed and my face lifted." Then I'll look at all these men and say "What do I want with these old codgers?"
